**OVERALL INSPECTION COMMENTS**

COVID-19

The purpose of this visit is to determine compliance with the current Health Officer Order.

The investigation revealed the facility was in-compliance with the Health Officer Order and applicable reopening protocol(s).

The following were observed at time of inspection:

- Operator reports temperature checks and screenings for COVID-19 symptoms performed daily for both staff and campers before start of camp.
- Operator reports total current enrollment of 4 campers and 1 staff member.
- Operator reports mandatory face masks for all campers and staff in indoor spaces except when eating or drinking.
- Observed all staff and campers wearing masks during indoor sewing activity. Observed 3 campers without masks while eating and drinking in designated outdoor area.
- Observed signage instructing mandatory mask use and instructing those who are sick to stay away.
- Operator reports assigning individual equipment to each camper to minimize sharing of equipment. Operator reports sanitizing all equipment between uses.
- Operator reports entire facility sanitized daily.
- Observed hand sanitizer and sanitizing solution throughout facility.

No further action required.

Pursuant to the current Health Officer Order for the Control of COVID-19, failure to comply with the Health Officer Order is a crime punishable by fine, imprisonment or both (California Health and Safety Code Section 120295 and Los Angeles County Code Section 11.02.080).

The provisions of the current Health Officer Order are in effect and shall remain in effect until extended, rescinded, superseded, or amended.
